Health and Safety

The headteacher and governors are responsible for health and safety issues within the nursery.

Regular checks are carried out and documented, on the building and equipment by nominated staff or by approved contractors.

Risk assessments are carried out for all areas of the nursery and for all activities and trips.

Oaklands Nursery and Oaklands Childcare have Public Liability Insurance policies.

All staff have First Aid training and a first aid box is available in every kitchen.

Procedures are in place to ensure:

- High standards of cleaning and hygiene are adhered to.
- Children are supervised at all times.
- External doors and gates are kept closed and can only be opened by the adults.
- Children will be handed to the designated adult collecting them and will only be allowed to go with the recognised parent or carer.
- Rulings in the 'illness' and 'medication' sections will be adhered to.

NO SMOKING POLICY

Oaklands Nursery provides a healthy environment for children, staff and parents and supports national guidelines for smoking cessation.

Oaklands Nursery is a no smoking area.

Smoking is not permitted either in the building or in the grounds.

No smoking notices are posted around the building.

Parents are informed of the policy at their induction.

Visitors and anyone working on the premises are made aware of the policy.
