**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC**

**B5370 HIGH STREET, NEWCASTLE-UNDER-LYME**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council intend not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the following lengths of B5370 High Street in Newcastle-under-Lyme;

from its junction with B5370 Watlands Avenue to its junction with Park Avenue,  
from its junction with Park Avenue to its junction with Woodland Avenue,  
from its junction with Boulton Street to its junction with Keeling Street;

unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works; or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Pedestrian access will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via B5370 High Street, B5370 Church Lane, A527 Church Lane, B5369 Alexandra Road, B5369 Dimsdale Parade East, B5370 Watlands View and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://roadworks.org?tm=105164680>.

**The order will come into operation on 8 May 2018 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 June 2018.**

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the gas mains replacement works undertaken by Balfour Beatty, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
