Transition to school

At this time of year we are thinking about our children moving on either to primary school or from the 2 year old room into the 3 year old room.

It's an exciting time but also can make children feel a little unsure of what it will be like.

Your children will be having **visits to their new school/new room**—it is really important to attend as many of these as you can so the children will have a chance to meet their new teachers and get to know their new surroundings.

Oaklands staff will meet with the new teachers to **share information** about what they enjoy, how they learn and some of the things that are important to them—this helps with their move to school.

Reassure your children by talking positively about the new school/new room, talk about the new things they will come across—dinner times will be different, school uniform, playtimes. In nursery we let children role play with dinner trays, book bags, school uniform.....
